

Student Learning Outcomes Assessment

The process by which evidence is gathered and reviewed to determine the extent to which students are achieving the intended educational outcomes. The goal of student learning outcomes assessment is continuous improvement.

Program Goals

Broad statements that direct the overall structure of the program, including what the program intends to accomplish.

Program-level Student Learning Outcomes

Program-level Student Learning Outcomes describe measurable knowledge and skills that *students* should be able to demonstrate as a result of completing the program.

Course-level Student Learning Outcomes

Course-level Student Learning Outcomes describe measurable knowledge and skills that *students* should be able to demonstrate as a result of completing the course.

Course Objectives

Written from the perspective of the instructor, course objectives identify what that instructor intends to teach or cover in the course.
