

### A Time for Change: Civil Rights in South Jersey

The exhibit that profiles the historic roles played by our region in the struggle for African-American Civil Rights is on display in the Bjork Library (E-Wing on the Stockton main campus) through December 15. Previously exhibited at the Noyes Arts Garage, the exhibit was funded by the New Jersey Council for the Humanities and Stockton 2020 funds, with additional support from the Stockton schools of General Studies and Arts and Humanities.
