First Wednesday Professional Lecture: Developing a Handicap Scale for Measurement of Dual Sensory Loss in Older Adults

Presented by: Debra Busacco, Ph.D., Assistant Professor of Health Sciences, RSCNJ; SCOSA Research Fellow.

This presentation will focus on the physical, social and psychological impact of dual sensory loss in older adults. Dr. Busacco will present a scale she developed to assess the handicapping effects of hearing and vision loss in this population. Clinical implications of using the results of this scale to determine an older adult's candidacy for auditory and/or visual rehabilitation programs will be addressed.

The seminar, designed for professionals, para-professionals, and other caregivers who work with older adults is free of charge and includes a light breakfast. Upon completion, participants will receive 1 CE for Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Licensed Professional Counselors.
