VIDEO CONFERENCING TIPS

CHUNK

Break a 60-minute lecture into six 10-minute segments to help students focus and learn better.

SEGMENT



ACTIVE LEARNING




PACE

Alternate between lecture (talking) and activities to promote student attention and learning.

GROUP

Use Zoom breakout rooms to group 5-7 students for a lively discussion. In the main Zoom room, groups may share a brief discussion summary with the entire class.

Zoom conferencing is visual.

Although faces are interesting,
consider screen sharing
PowerPoints, videos and images
to capture student attention.

Avoid too much text.

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
