

**TEDU Course Planning Template for PreSchool-3 certification areas**

This template can be used to help map your path to teacher certification. The sheet ONLY shows required courses for teacher certification. This should be used in conjunction with your selected liberal arts degree path. This is based on an approximately 16 credit per term load. Flat rate tuition allows between 16-20 credits per term. Electing to take more courses per term and/or summer courses can impact timing.

The following professional requirement courses are required but may be taken whenever you choose:
