1.0 EMERITUS/EMERITA STATUS

- 1.1 Emeritus or Emerita status is conveyed by action of the Board of Trustees to selected retiring faculty at the rank of Associate Professor or above, tenured with at least 10 years of service, who are in good standing with the University at the time of retirement. Program faculty nominate the retiring faculty to the Dean, who makes a recommendation to the Provost. Emeritus or Emerita status is awarded upon the recommendation of the President after consultation with the Provost.
- 1.2 Emeritus or Emerita faculty status is considered by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the calendar to award tenure and promotion.
- 1.3 Faculty awarded Emeritus/a status will have Emeritus/a added to the end of the rank or title earned at the time of their retirement.
