1. A. Within Academic Affairs, the Committee on Research and Professional Development is a University-wide body responsible for making recommendations through the Provost to the President concerning proposals for sabbaticals and Research and Professional Development projects. The Committee's role is to make critical evaluations of proposals on their intrinsic merits, so as to use limited financial resources most wisely and to provide reasonable assurance as to the quality of proposals. The Committee does not consider such questions as to whether an applicant can be spared from teaching or other duties, whether devotion to a project will otherwise detract from the applicant's primary function as a teacher or administrator, or whether suitable replacements can be found. Such considerations will be addressed by the appropriate Deans/Directors, Provost, and the President. Composition and election of Committee members and Chair are set forth in the Constitution of the Faculty or any superseding faculty governance body.
