EPA Administrator to address Stockton Energy Symposium

GALLOWAY TWP. – Lisa P. Jackson, administrator for the United States Environmental Protection Agency, will be the keynote speaker for the Energy Symposium sponsored by the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey. The symposium will be held from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 22, 2012 at the Stockton College Campus Center Event room.

The theme is “Energy 40/40,” which ties into the college’s yearlong celebration of 40 years of teaching. Speakers and panelists will reflect on the history of energy over the past four decades and look forward to things we might expect over the next 40 years.
