

As part of his continuing efforts on behalf of veterans, Connors, along with Senator James Whelan, is a prime sponsor of legislation (S-1026) that would establish a pilot teacher preparation program at Richard Stockton College for veterans who served in the armed forces on or after Sept. 11, 2001.

The activities for the final day of the program included Connors discussing coastal erosion and dune maintenance with faculty from the Coastal Research Center as well as meeting with student representatives from various organizations and clubs for a roundtable on "How College Students Can Impact the Political Process."
