## Fall 2008 Enrollment Report* SUMMARY STATEMENTS

## TOTAL ENROLLMENT

- Total headcount for fall 2008 is 7,307 , representing a decrease of 48 students over last fall's total headcount of 7,355. Total FTE increased by approximately $0.7 \%$ to 6,322 .


## NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

- With regard to new undergraduates (freshmen and transfer/re-admits) in fall 2008:
- There are 842 new freshmen and 957 transfer/re-admits. This represents an increase of 43 freshman and a decrease of 131 transfer/re-admits for an overall decrease of 88 new undergraduate students.
- The total SAT for first-time regularly admitted freshmen is 1130 and the average high school rank is the 80th percentile.
- The Honors Program has 40 new freshman participants, which has positive ramifications for future recruitment efforts.
- There are 152 new graduate students enrolled: 55 of these are enrolled in Stockton's new doctoral program in Physical Therapy.


## UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Third-semester retention rates for first-time full-time freshmen remained strong at $83 \%$.
- Undergraduate FTE increased by 6 to 5,978, while the actual headcount of undergraduate students decreased by 95 to 6,671, as compared to last fall.
- Females constitute $58 \%$ of the total undergraduate class; $42 \%$ are male. These percentages are consistent with previous years and with national trends.


## GRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Graduate and post-baccalaureate FTE increased by $13 \%$ over fall 2007 to a record of 344.
- Headcount increased by 47 students to a record number of 636 students.
