## Fall 2010 Enrollment Report* SUMMARY STATEMENTS

## TOTAL ENROLLMENT

- Total headcount for fall 2010 is 7,879 representing an increase of $320(4 \%)$ students over last fall's total headcount of 7,559. Total FTE increased by approximately 312 (5\%) to 7013 .


## NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

- With regard to new undergraduates (freshmen and transfer/re-admits) in fall 2010:
- There are 862 new freshmen and 1154 transfer/re-admits. This represents a decrease of 8 freshmen and an increase of 49 transfer/re-admits for an overall increase of 41 new undergraduate students.
- The average combined SAT (Verbal and Math) for first-time regularly admitted freshmen is 1122 and the average high school rank is the 79th percentile.
- There are 212 new graduate students enrolled including 11 new students enrolled in the new Certificate Program for Communication Disorders.


## UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Undergraduate FTE increased by $289(5 \%)$ to 6570 , while the actual headcount of undergraduate students increased by 249 to 7062 , a $4 \%$ increase compared to last fall.
- $58 \%$ of the total undergraduate class are female and $42 \%$ are male.
- The retention rate for undergraduate students increased significantly from 81.2\% in Fall 2009 to $87.4 \%$ this semester.


## GRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Graduate and post-baccalaureate FTE increased by 23 over fall 2009 to a record of 443.
- Headcount increased by 71 students, nearly $10 \%$ to a record number of 817 students.
