SUMMARY STATEMENTS

TOTAL ENROLLMENT

• Total headcount for Fall 2013 has increased slightly to 8,458, compared with 8,400 for Fall 2012. Total FTE increased by 3% to 7,926 from the previous Fall's 7,723.

NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT

- New undergraduate students:
 - There are 1,069 new freshmen—7% more than the previous Fall, and 1,087 transfer/re-admits.
 - The average combined SAT (Verbal and Math) for first-time regularly admitted freshmen is 1110 and the average high school rank is the 78th percentile.
- New graduate students:

There are 298 new graduate students enrolled— 255 who have just begun studies at the graduate level, and 43 who returned to begin a second graduate program (degree, certification, or endorsement).

UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT

- Undergraduate FTE increased by 2% to 7,375 from last Fall's 7,201, while the actual headcount of undergraduate students increased slightly to 7,539 from last Fall's 7,516.
- Gender distribution for total undergraduate population remains steady: 60% female and 40% male.

GRADUATE ENROLLMENT

• Graduate and post-baccalaureate FTE increased by 6% to 551 from Fall 2012, while headcount increased by 4% to a total of 919 students, compared with the previous Fall.
