

### THE RICHARD STOCKTON COLLEGE OF NEW JERSEY SPRING 2001 FINAL ENROLLMENT REPORT -Summary-

#### **Spring 2001 Enrollment:**

#### **New Students**

<u>Undergraduate</u>: The 490 new undergraduates who registered this semester include 27 first-time freshmen, 398 transfer students, and 65 readmitted students.

Graduate: Thirty-five new students enrolled in four of Stockton's six graduate programs.

#### Headcount & FTE

<u>Total Population</u>: There are a record **6095** students registered, generating a record FTE of **5050**.

<u>Undergraduate:</u> The **5763** students enrolled this semester represent a record headcount. The corresponding FTE, also a record, is **4829**.

<u>Graduate:</u> Graduate student enrollment experienced a slight decrease, from 337 to 332. This is attributed to a decrease in the number of MBS students. Graduate FTE, however, experienced a 10% increase to a record **221**.

Matriculated vs. Non-matriculated Students: The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students remains stable at 95%, and increased from 76% to 80% for graduate students.

<u>Credit load:</u> Undergraduates maintained their average of 13.4 credits this semester, while graduate students increased their average credit load from 7.1 to 8.0.

#### AY00-01 Annualized Headcount & FTE

<u>Total Population:</u> The combined annualized headcount is a record **6204** students, which exceeds last year's record by 2%. FTE generated was a record **5173**, and also exceeds last year's record by 2%.

<u>Undergraduate:</u> The AY00-01 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is 5870 students, a 1% increase over the AY99-00 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is a record **4957**, an increase of 2%.

<u>Graduate:</u> The graduate annualized headcount is a record **334** students, a 1% increase over the AY99-00 record. A record **216** FTE was generated, which represents a 14% increase over the record set in AY99-00.

Annualized data are determined by averaging fall and spring headcount and FTE figures.
