-SUMMARY-

Spring 2003 Enrollment:

New Students

<u>Undergraduate:</u> The **542** new undergraduates who registered this semester include **17** first-time freshmen, **443** transfer students, and **82** readmitted students.

<u>Graduate:</u> **46** new students enrolled in four of Stockton's six graduate programs.

Headcount & FTE

<u>Total Population</u>: There are **6358** students registered, generating **5349** FTE.

<u>Undergraduate:</u> The **6069** students enrolled this semester represent a record headcount. The corresponding FTE, also a record, is **5151**.

<u>Graduate:</u> There are **289** students enrolled this semester with a corresponding FTE of **198**.

<u>Matriculated vs. Non-matriculated Students:</u> The percentage of matriculated undergraduate students remains stable at 95%, and increased from 83% to 87% for graduate students.

<u>Credit load:</u> Undergraduates achieved a record high of 13.6 credits this semester, while graduate students maintained an average credit load of 8.2.

AY02-03 Annualized¹ Headcount & FTE

<u>Total Population:</u> The combined annualized headcount is a record **6448** students, which exceeds last year's record by 2%. FTE generated was a record **5444**, and also exceeds last year's record by 3%.

<u>Undergraduate:</u> The AY02-03 annualized headcount for undergraduate students is **6165** students, a **2%** increase over the AY01-02 annualized headcount. The corresponding FTE is a record **5251, an** increase of 3%.

Graduate: The graduate annualized headcount is 283 students with a corresponding FTE of 193.
