Galloway Township, NJ - The 14th Annual Day of Scholarship has grown into a two-day showcase of distinctive research projects and collaborations between students, faculty and staff from all fields of study at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey.

Day of Scholarship will take place on **Wednesday, March 19** and **Thursday, March 20, 2014** from 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. in the Campus Center, located on the college's main Galloway campus. Beth Olsen, director of Grants Development, will welcome guests with opening remarks and Dr. Harvey Kesselman, provost and executive vice president of the college, will speak at the afternoon luncheons at 12:15 p.m.

Faculty, staff and students from all eight of the Stockton's academic schools will deliver close to 100 presentations during the two-day event. The presentations are open to the public. Bringing together a diverse pool of talent, the event provides an overview of the projects that took place during the past year including grant-funded projects, internally funded projects, research endeavors, professional development, sabbaticals, study tours and academic achievements.

There are 30-minute presentations as well as longer 60-minute panel discussions that give multiple perspectives on various topics. Posters will be on display all day both days.

The topics include the children and the Holocaust, various physical therapy studies, teaching abroad, student leadership in community engagement and digital learning curation.
