Galloway Township, NJ- Stockton College's Kramer Hall celebrates Hammonton's October Third Thursday event on **Oct. 17, 2013,** with the showing of "Haunted, Inc.," a movie directed and produced by Kent Green, a senior audio visual technician in Stockton Production Services, and college video production employee Ernie Rockelman. The film will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Eagle Theatre.

"This spooky fun film takes us on an adventure with two down-on-their-luck roommates looking for an easy way to pay the rent, answering an unusual ad in the local paper, and scaring up more than just money," said Green and Rockelman.

As an extra bonus, their award-winning short film, "Ghost Light," will precede the feature presentation.

A ghost light is a theater light turned on each night to keep the stage out of darkness. "The legend says that theaters put out the ghost light to distract past performers who have passed away—to keep the ghosts at bay," explained Green.
