**Galloway Township, NJ-** The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will host the 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Jersey Shore Science Fair on **Saturday, March 20, 2010** in the Sports Center on the College's main Galloway Township campus. The Sports Center will be open to the public from **12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.** for guests to view the student projects.

Currently, there are more than 500 sixth through twelfth graders from 29 different schools registered in the competition. Over 600 students are expected. Dr. Dennis Weiss, Dean of the School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics said, "The Jersey Shore Science Fair has become a Stockton tradition. Each year the level of competition rises and the science projects become more complex and creative."

The judges, who are experts in their fields, come from the FAA Technical Center, local medical centers, and area colleges. Also, the International Test Evaluation Association (ITEA) is donating a \$250.00 scholarship to a high school junior or senior.

The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners of the Jersey Shore Science Fair will go on to the Delaware Valley Fair where they will have the opportunity to win multiple prizes. Selected high school juniors and seniors will be awarded scholarships, including one from Drexel University.
