Schenk is a Hammonton local and creator of handcrafted and Earth-friendly designs for fashion and the home, made mostly with repurposed materials. Her collection is found at the Antique Marketplace of Downtown Hammonton.

Schenk will invite guests to Kramer Hall to create and decorate an Accomplishment Jar to take home as a new way to capture the traditional New Year's Resolution.

A positive life and mind doesn't just happen, it takes daily dedication and awareness of training your mind to think a certain way, Schenk explained. The more you do it, the more it becomes a habit and then a way of life.

"This year I am proposing a challenge to fill 2016 with positive thoughts," she said. All are welcome to bring their own pieces to jazz up their jars, but there also will be glitzy items available for all to use.
