Galloway, NJ – Stockton University's Manahawkin Instructional Site will host a Lunch & Learn lecture on minimally invasive management of common hand conditions on **Wednesday, April 20, 2016**. The free event, which includes a light lunch, will be presented at the Manahawkin Instructional Site, located at 712 E. Bay Ave., at noon.

The presentation will be given by Dr. Kevin Lutsky of Rothman Institute, a hand and upper extremity surgeon who specializes in the treatment of complex disorders of the hand, wrist and elbow.

Dr. Lutsky's clinical expertise includes arthroscopy of the wrist and hand; management of trauma and complex fractures of the hand, wrist and elbow; compressive neuropathies such as carpal and cubital tunnel syndromes; peripheral nerve and tendon injuries; and arthritis of the wrist and hand.
