**Galloway**, **NJ** – Stockton University's Manahawkin Instructional Site will host a Lunch & Learn lecture about Holocaust denial on **Tuesday**, **March 15**, **2016**.

Although there is an abundance of evidence that the Holocaust occurred, some people deny that over six million Jews and others were murdered by the Nazis during World War II. Some organizations and individuals have chosen to negate and manipulate the historical proof, instead claiming that the entire event was a hoax. This presentation will discuss these allegations as well as the landmark court case of Holocaust denier David Irving, who sued the American historian Deborah Lipstadt and her publisher for libel over statements about him in her book, "Denying the Holocaust." Irving lost.

The presenter, Rebekah Sabo, is currently a senior at Stockton University studying literature and education. She is the current president of STAND, an anti-genocide coalition on campus, and will be entering the Master of Art in Holocaust and Genocide Studies program this summer.

The free event, which provides lunch, will be held at the Manahawkin Instructional Site, located at 712 E. Bay Ave., at noon.
