The auditions will be held **Tuesday, Oct. 15** from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at Dante Hall Theater, located at 14 N. Mississippi Ave, Atlantic City. Interested parties must be 16 or older and present a one-two minute monologue. Interested parties should also be prepared to sing 16 bars of music either a cappella or accompanied by a CD track.
