Galloway Township, NJ- Law enforcement professionals from New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and Delaware will attend the 9th Annual Excellence in Policing Leadership and Accreditation Conference at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey on **Tuesday, Oct. 29** and **Wednesday, Oct. 30.**

Retired Gen. Barry McCaffrey, a frequent military commentator on NBC and MSNBC, will give the keynote address at 9 a.m. on Tuesday during the two-day conference in the Campus Center Theatre.

McCaffrey was the most highly decorated four-star general in the Army when he retired in 1996 after 32 years in the service.

The conference offers courses that support accreditation managers whose job it is to administer an accreditation program for their agency such as the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police (NJSACOP) Law Enforcement Accreditation Program or the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA) accreditation programs.

The conference is co-sponsored by the New Jersey Public Safety Accreditation Coalition, the NJSACOP and Stockton's Center for Public Safety and Security.

Other speakers over the two days include Major Ron Stucker of the Orange County, Florida Sheriff's Office, on Handling a High Profile Case: The Casey Anthony Trial; and Officer Jared Reston of the Jacksonville Police Department, on Winning an Armed Encounter.
