Galloway Township, NJ – The Stockton Center on Successful Aging (SCOSA) will present an Apple Drying Basket Weaving workshop on **Saturday, Sept. 14 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** at the Noyes Museum of Art, 733 Lily Lake Road, Oceanville NJ.

Niki Giberson, owner and operator of Swan Bay Farm in Port Republic will instruct the class. Participants will receive all of the materials and instructions to weave a 12" x 20" x 4" rectangular basket – traditionally hung from the rafters and used to dry apple slices. The basket can hold and transport two dozen cupcakes.
