Galloway Township, NJ- The Stockton Center on Successful Aging (SCOSA) is sponsoring a "Learn to Draw" workshop series for older adults at the Atlantic County Library System in Egg Harbor Township in September and October.

Participants will meet at the Library, located at 1 Swift Drive in Egg Harbor Township, in the Community Meeting Room. The class will meet 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. on the following Wednesdays: September 10, 17, 24 and October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29.

Tom Sandor, a local artist, will be instructing the workshop series. Guided by Sandor's experience and expertise, participants will learn to draw what they see, at their own pace, developing powers of observation and defining individual style. With emphasis on self-discovery and skill development, the class will focus on building and refining basic skills, exploring a broad range of drawing materials and sharing ideas and techniques.

Participants must purchase and bring their own materials. A fee of \$5 per session will be charged and collected by the instructor at each class. No experience is necessary, but those with a sample of previous work are encouraged to bring it to the class.
