Galloway Township, NJ- The Stockton Center on Successful Aging (SCOSA) is sponsoring a free two-part workshop to help older adults navigate the job market on two consecutive Wednesdays, **June 4** and **June 11**, at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey.

The workshop titled "F.O.C.U.S. How to Get Hired in Today's Job Market" will take place on the college's main Galloway campus in the Campus Center's Meeting Room 1 from 2 to 3 p.m. on both days. The course covers most aspects of the job search, including where to find open positions, applications and resumes, interviewing techniques, missteps to avoid and related topics.

Ventnor native Rosemary Molloy will lead the workshop. Molloy is a SCOSA volunteer instructor and served as the manager of employment at her alma mater, Rider University, for 27 years. She is a member of the Little Egg Theatre Company and Players & Playwrights at the Jersey Shore, and she has appeared in "Steel Magnolias," "Night Must Fall," "You Can't Take It With You," "Arsenic and Old Lace," and a variety of other productions. She wrote and directed several one-act plays, which were performed at Dante Hall in Atlantic City and the Little Egg Harbor library.
