The class will meet on **Tuesdays, May 27, June 3, June 10 and June 17, 2014** from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Alice White-Marks, a local artist and SCOSA volunteer, will be instructing the workshop series, "Learn to Paint with Watercolors: Beginning Watercolor for Mature Adults." Learn the fundamentals of painting with watercolors in this four-week course.

White-Marks will discuss the selection of brushes, paints and watercolor papers, as well as other related topics. Students will learn basic techniques as they begin to paint.

The instructor will supply initial painting inspiration, but students are encouraged to develop their own inspirations as well. The class is geared toward mature adults, but all adults are welcome. You must purchase and bring your own materials. No experience necessary, however, those with a sample of previous work are encouraged to bring it to the class.
