Galloway Township, NJ- Ocean County students can hit the books and then the beach by enrolling in summer classes at The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey's Manahawkin site, just five minutes from Long Beach Island.

Stockton's eight summer sessions, which have start dates in May, June and July, are open to students enrolled in degree programs, non-matriculated students and students currently enrolled at other institutions. A summer tuition discount for undergraduate courses is offered. Students can save more than \$300 for each four-credit undergraduate course.

The following courses are being offered at the Manahawkin Instructional Site: "Phonetics," "Computing Concepts," "Sign Language," "The Philadelphia Experience," "Statistics," "Veterans: A Global Vision," "Language Disorders" and "Justice, Virtue and Moral Philosophy."

Madeleine Coleman, a current Stockton student and Seaside Park resident, has taken four courses in Manahawkin since its opening this past fall. "The faculty and staff are welcoming and it's an intimate setting. Not only is it convenient to take courses in Manahawkin, it helps save on gas and allows me more time and flexibility for my work schedule," explained Coleman.

Summer sessions enable students to graduate sooner or lighten their course loads during the fall or spring semesters.
