Niki Giberson, owner of Swan Bay Folk Art Center in Port Republic, will guide participants through the creation of a hand-woven oval serving basket, measuring 14" x 8" x 3" high, with wooden and wire handles. A beginner's level basket, it is perfect for displaying fall gourd arrangements, holiday greens, or as a fruit basket. Each participant will leave with a completed basket in this two-hour workshop. There is a \$30.00 fee charged for each participant that covers the cost of materials.
