

Stockton Offers Free Depression Screening and Information Sessions for Older Adults throughout Atlantic and Cape May Counties

Galloway Township, NJ- A series of community workshops directed by Stockton College's Dr. Christine Ferri, Associate Professor of Psychology and Education Chair for the Stockton Center on Successful Aging (SCOSA) will address depression among older adults in the community. The Depression Screening program is made possible by a grant from The Horizon Foundation for New Jersey. The Horizon Foundation for New Jersey's mission is to promote health, well-being, and quality of life in New Jersey's communities.

The program is designed to address three barriers toward the treatment of depression in older adults: lack of knowledge about depression, limited access to information about mental health providers who accept Medicare and challenges associated with depressed individuals' willingness to follow through with referrals.

"The Depression Screening Program will address these barriers by presenting events in the community that target high-risk groups," Ferri said. The events include an information session and depression screening. Ferri will also distribute a list of mental health providers who accept Medicare. Professor Ferri and her research team will also make follow-up phone calls to determine if participants made an appointment and provide further encouragement to seek treatment.
