EPA Seeks Local Partners to Enhance Environmental Education

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is soliciting applications for the 2018 Environmental Education (EE) Local Grant Program. Approximately \$3 million will be spread out between EPA's 10 regions to promote increased environmental and

conservation literacy and encourage behavior that will benefit the environment in local communities. Each region is expected to award three to four grants this cycle, meaning applicants would only be competing against other local entities for multiple chances at funding. EPA does require cost-sharing and exactly 25 percent of the total award amount must go to subgrantees. Applications are due by March 15, 2018.
